



FRIENDS- How Many Of Us Have Them?

Christian friendships are nothing like worldly friendships; they're much stronger, more resilient, and built on the principles that Jesus Christ established. When we look at these types of biblical relationships, we see the characteristics of selflessness and Christian love.

We have heard the term "**blood is thicker than water**" and for some that statement is true. Unfortunately for some, they have discovered that's not the case because they have encountered people who are not family, who treat them better than their actual family, so Zora Neale Hurston's famous quote, "All skin folk ain't kinfolk" for some proves to be oh so true.

Jesus powerfully modeled the following "*This is my commandment, that ye love one another, as I have loved you. Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends*" (John 15:12, 13).

Compared to what we see in the world, the kind of relationships God wants for us are those that foster emotional health and wellbeing. They involve putting the other person's interests before our own, and providing godly advice when they need direction in life.




Prayer for the Month
