Breast Cancer Prevention - Avoiding risk factors and increasing protective factors may help prevent cancer. The following are risk factors for breast cancer:

Older age, A personal history of breast cancer or benign (noncancer) breast disease, Inherited risk of breast cancer, Dense breast tissue, Reproductive history resulting in greater exposure to estrogen, Taking hormone therapy for symptoms of menopause, Radiation therapy to the breast or chest, Obesity, Drinking alcohoL
